### Introduction

The International Association of Anti-Corruption Authorities (IAACA) will host its **Annual Conference** on **13 December 2025**, in collaboration with the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime, the Administrative Control and Transparency Authority of Qatar and the Independent Commission Against Corruption of Hong Kong, China.

This annual event will serve as a dynamic platform for IAACA members and anti-corruption practitioners to exchange insights, explore innovative strategies to combat corruption, and shape the future direction of IAACA's initiatives. Through fostering collaboration, sharing expertise, and developing actionable solutions, the conference aims to strengthen collective efforts and advance global anti-corruption progress.

The conference will act as a pre-event to the 11th Session of the Conference of the States Parties to the United Nations Convention against Corruption (CoSP 11) in Doha, Qatar.

### **Venue**

The Annual Conference will be held at the **Marriott Marquis City Center Doha Hotel** which is located at West Bay City Center, Omar Al Mukhtar Street, PO BOX 25500, Doha, Qatar.

The Conference will be conducted in English, with simultaneous interpretation available in Arabic.



### **Visa**

To enter Qatar, all international participants must hold a valid passport with at least three months validity from the date of entry and obtain an entry visa via the Hayya Platform.

The Host will provide each participant with an individual letter confirming their permission to enter Doha, Qatar, upon request. This letter can be presented if required during check-in, passport control, or boarding.

## **Accommodation**

Participants are responsible for making their own hotel reservations. Complimentary refreshments such as coffee breaks and a buffet lunch will be provided on the conference day.

## **Transportation**

Hamad International Airport (DOH) is approximately 19 km from the conference venue. While delegates are responsible for their own airport transfers, those attending the CoSP11 may use the complimentary shuttle service provided by the organizers.



### **Useful Information about Qatar**

#### Time Zone

UTC/GMT +3 hours

#### Climate

Doha, Qatar, will experience a desert climate during the annual conference in December 2025, with mild and pleasant temperatures ranging from 20°C to 25°C (68°F to 77°F) during the day. Rainfall is minimal, averaging around 75 mm (3 inches) annually, and is most likely to occur in the winter months. This period is characterized by high humidity levels, although the weather will be more comfortable compared to the extreme heat of summer.

#### **Electricity**

In Doha, Qatar, the electrical supply operates on a voltage of 240V and a frequency of 50Hz, using the British-style Type G three-pin plugs. Visitors should ensure they have the appropriate adapters and converters for their devices.

#### Currency

The official currency is the Qatari Rial (QAR), and all transactions in the country are conducted in Qatari Rials. Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in hotels, shops, and restaurants. ATMs are available for cash withdrawals in QAR. Mobile payment options like Apple Pay and Samsung Pay are also accepted almost everywhere.
